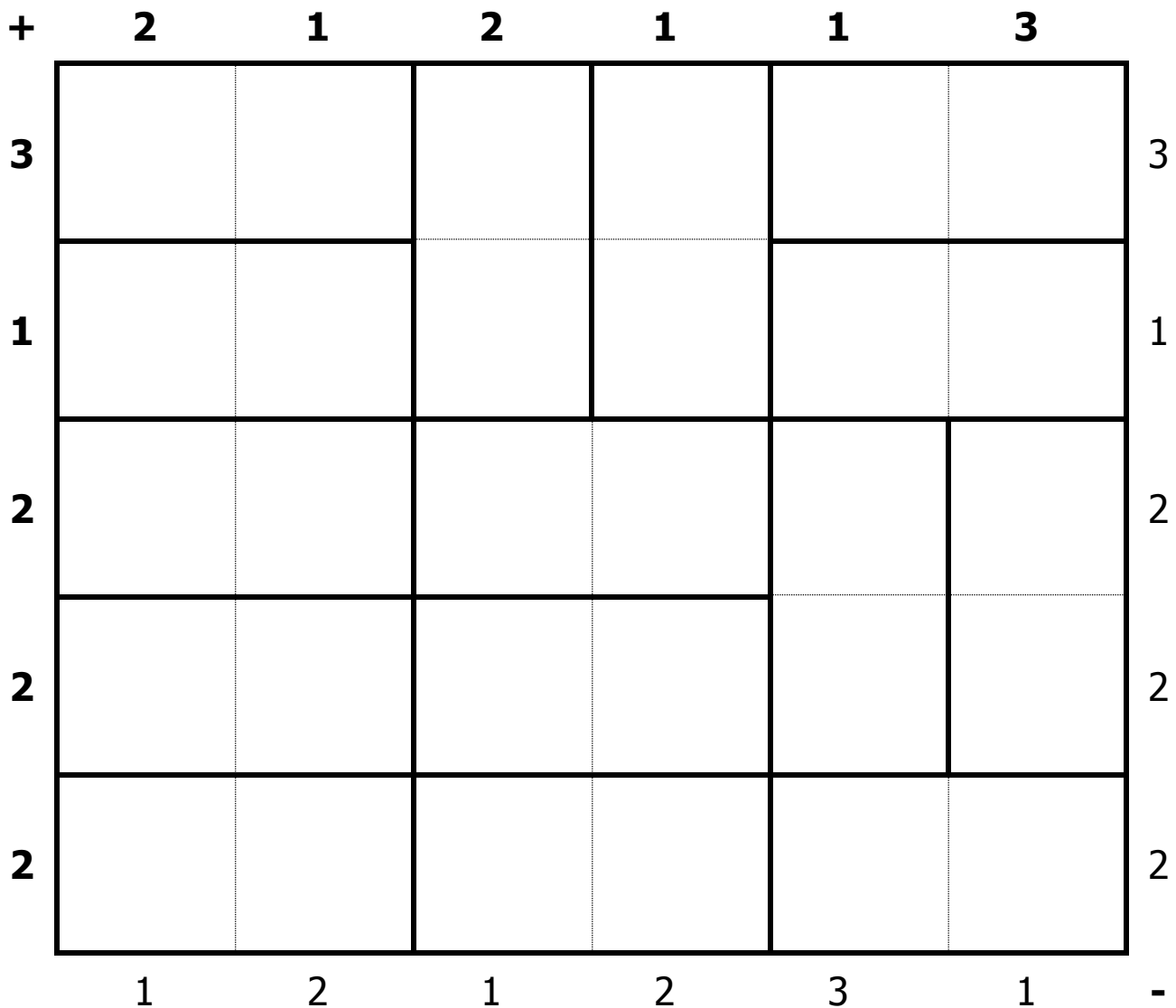


Magnets with manipulatives II.1 (a bit trickier)

Remember, you never need to guess – there is always a logical way to solve each puzzle.



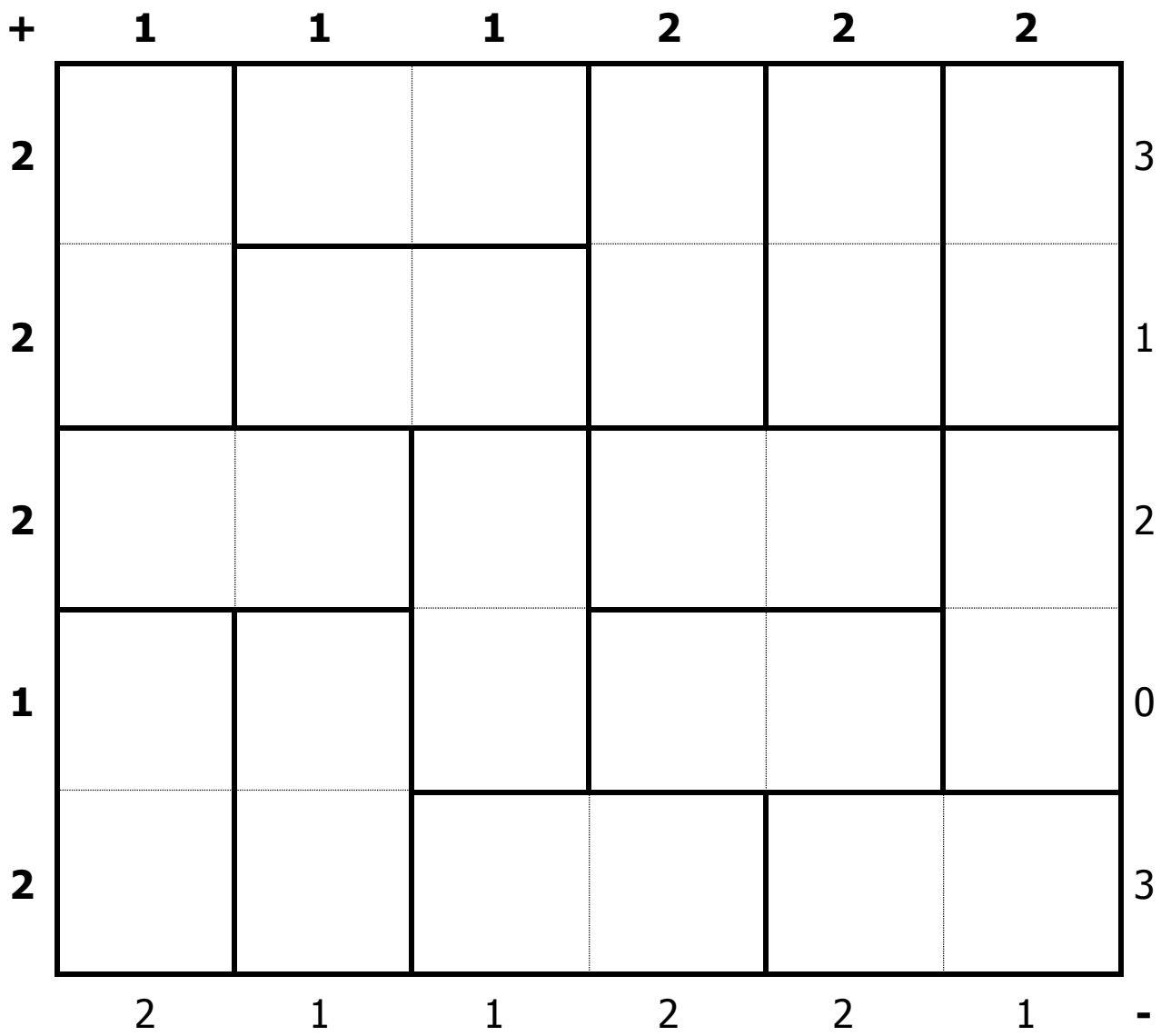
Magnets with manipulatives II.2

- Look for things you know for sure first, such as a *column* with 3 + signs or 3 - signs,
- or a piece that must be X X (think about the fourth column below!).
- Then put in some ?? pieces where you know there must be magnets, even if you can't say yet what they are. This will help you narrow things down.

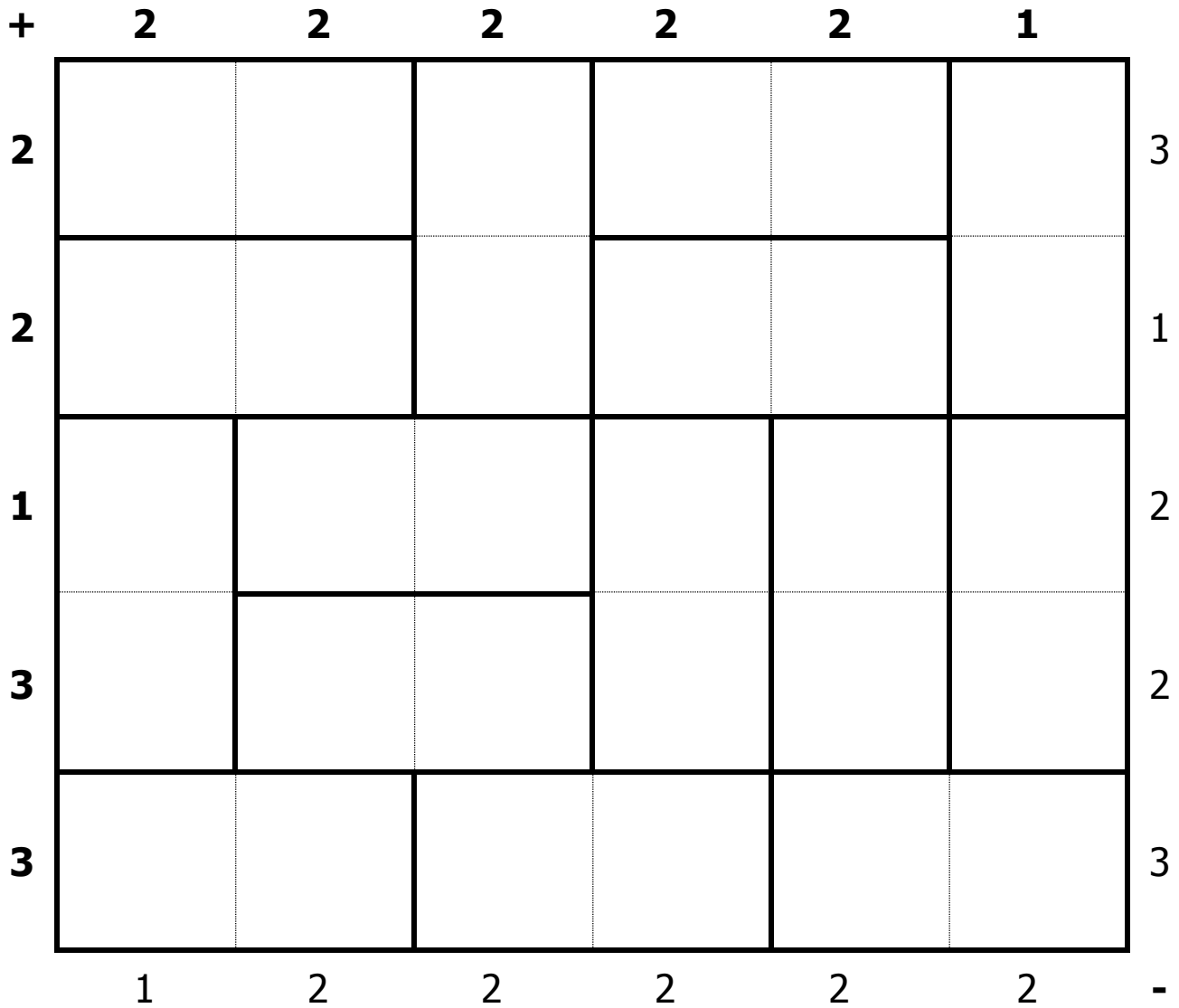

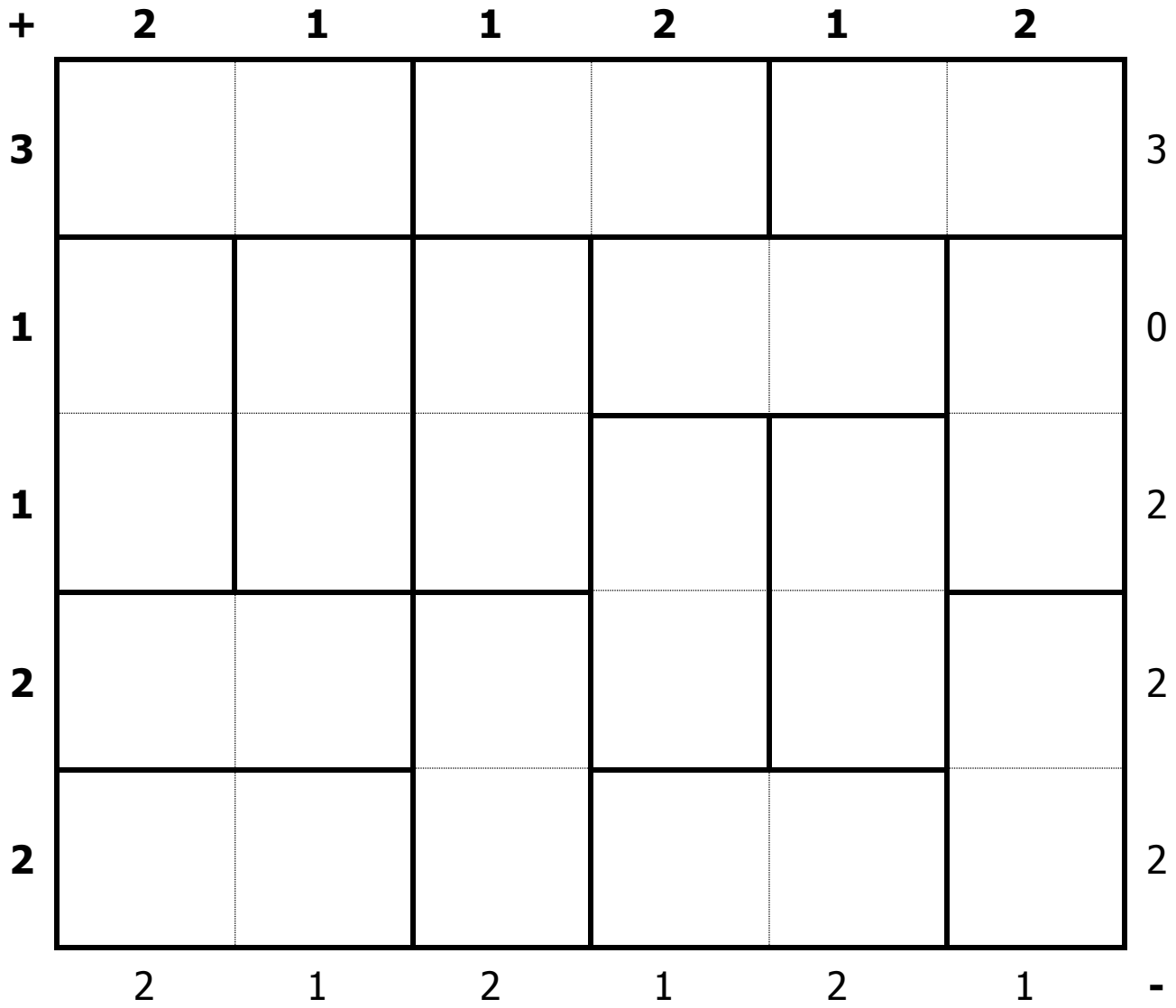

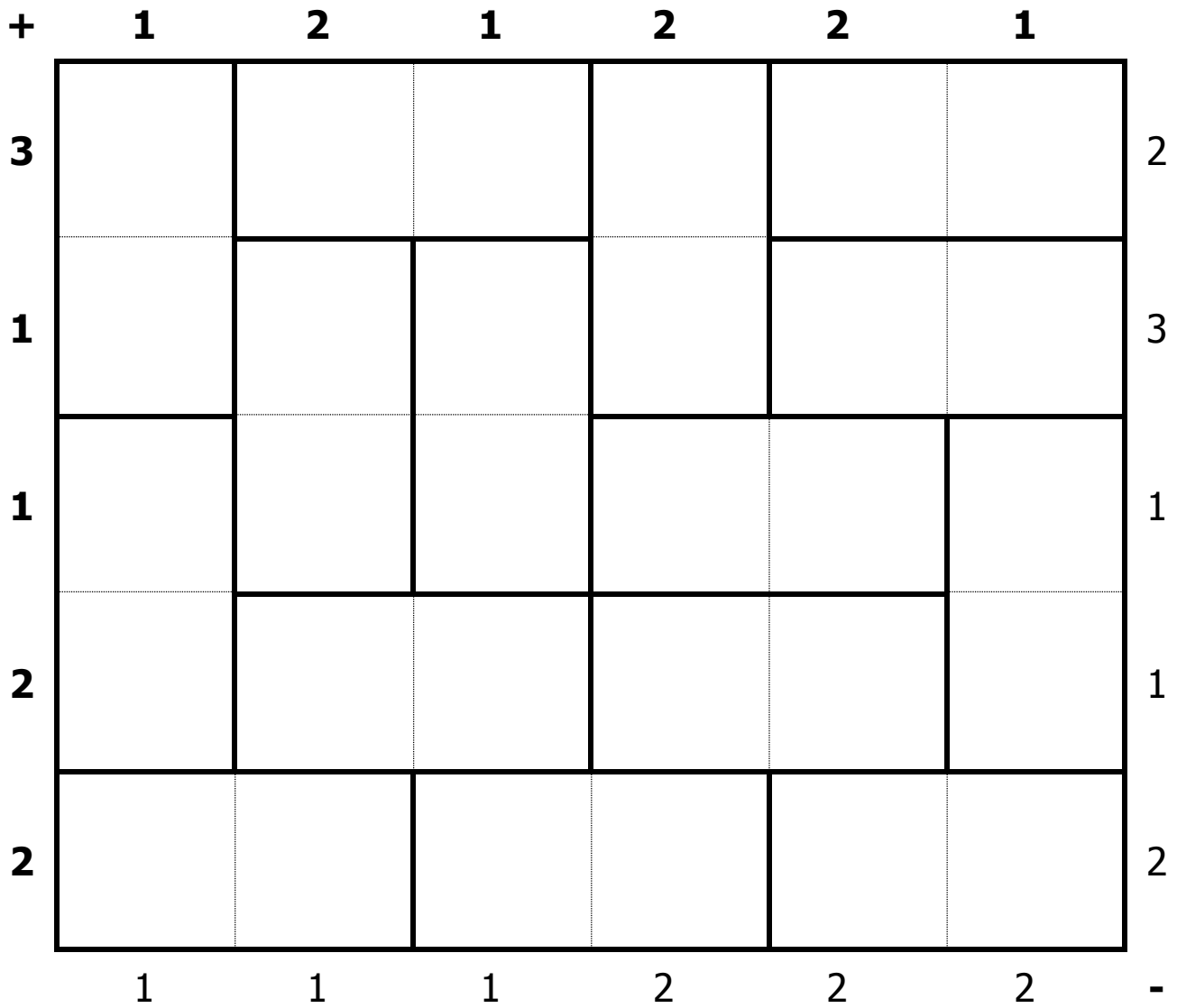
